3	<p>Treasurer's Report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CW reported that last year's accounts have now been finalised and are ready for RB to inspect prior to submission to OSCR. Income has gone up in several areas while our electricity bill has reduced considerably since the installation of the solar panels. This has resulted in a small surplus. No room for complacency, however, as we have a number of future commitments in relation to the building including a new front fence. It was agreed to set the date for the AGM where the accounts can be formally ratified. This will be on Wednesday 25th March at 7pm. FC to arrange for advert to be placed in WHFP as well as in the local newsletter. • Water consumption - the bills remain largely incomprehensible; however the bill has recently reduced from £53 per month to £10 per month • Security Protocols - CW has now established a digital 'lock-box' containing all relevant data. It was agreed that FC would be the additional approved person with access to this information • FC said that currently the domain name for the Hall website is tagged on to one of his personal accounts. As he is planning to close this account we need to look at an alternative arrangement. • 100 Club - it was noted that our original plan to hold a free community 'tea' catered by Zoe was not now feasible in the winter months.
